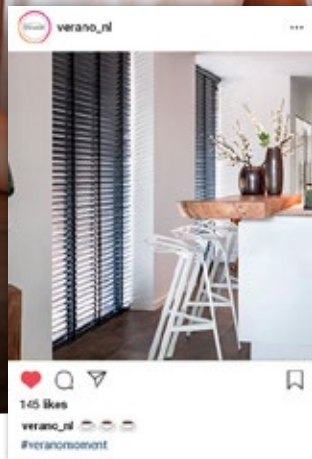

# SPRING CLEAN!

It goes without saying you are going to enjoy your new Verano® product(s) for as long as possible. You will therefore regularly need to clean the product. We recommend doing this on a monthly basis, making sure very thorough cleaning of your window styling can be avoided. This is because your window styling contain a protective layer which makes the product strong and sustainable. Scrubbing the product can affect the protective layer.

## ALSO CHECK:

Verano® products require little maintenance and have an incredibly long life. However, in the unlikely event of a product malfunction, contact your Verano® partner immediately. Make sure you check the following before you start cleaning your products:

- Distortion of the product
- Deviating sound when opening/closing

# CLEANING VENETIAN BLINDS AND VERTICAL BLINDS

## STEP 1

### Remove dust

Tilt the lamellae and remove the dust with a Swiffer or feather duster.



## STEP 2

### Remove stains

Use a damp cloth to remove any stubborn stains from the lamellae.



## STEP 3

### Pay attention

Be careful around the ladder tape and ladder cords. These are delicate.



# CLEANING PLEATED BLINDS

## STEP 1

### Remove dust

Remove dust from the slats with a feather duster, or use a vacuum cleaner on a low setting.



## STEP 2

### Remove stains

Any stains on the fabric can be removed with a soft sponge or cloth combined with luke-warm water.



## STEP 3

### Pay attention

Some fabrics have an extra protective layer, these may not get wet. Not sure? Check with your Verano® partner.



# CLEANING ROLLER BLINDS AND LINEE SHADES

## STEP 1

### Remove dust

Roller blinds and Linee Shades can easily be kept dust-free with a feather duster or (non-static) cloth.



## STEP 2

### Remove stains

Any stains on the roller blind can be removed with a sponge or cloth combined with luke-warm water. Be careful with scrubbing or rubbing. The fabric is very delicate.



## STEP 3

### Pay attention

Some fabrics have an extra protective layer, these may not get wet. Not sure? Check with your Verano® partner.





# CLEANING FOLDED BLINDS

## STEP 1

### Remove dust

Folded blinds can easily be kept dust-free with a feather duster or (non-static) cloth.



## STEP 2

### In the washing machine

Loosen the folded blind's dust at the velcro strips and remove the slats and cords from the blind. You can now wash the blinds at 30 degrees.



## STEP 3

### Add detergent

Use detergent sparingly. This could actually result in the fabric discolouring.



## CHILD SAFETY

Children are naturally curious about the world around them and will constantly be busy exploring it. This means even the simplest pieces of furniture and household items can pose a potential danger to them, including cords and chains of window styling and window coverings. Child safety is an important theme and we therefore take this very seriously!

Your product is fully compliant with the standards set by the European Commission. This sets strict safety rules for window styling to exclude the risk of strangulation or suffocation. The existing European CEN Standard EN 13120 has been reviewed and two standards have been added: EN 16433 and EN 16434.
