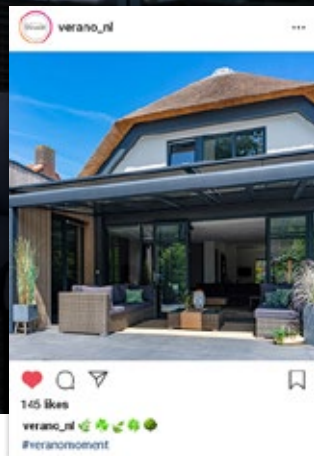

ALSO CHECK:

Verano® products require little maintenance and have an incredibly long life. However, in the unlikely event of a product malfunction, contact your Verano® partner immediately. Make sure you check the following before you start cleaning your products:

- Aluminium profiles
- Deviating sound when opening/closing

CLEANING VERANDA

STEP 1

Cleaning the gutters

All coarse dirt and foreign objects must be cleared from the gutters in order to warranty free water drainage. This also applies to snow and ice during the winter period.



STEP 2

Remove dirt

Remove any loose dirt with a brush or vacuum cleaner and rinse the roof plates with water.



STEP 3

Cleaning the roof plates

Clean the roof plates with lukewarm soapy water and wipe with a soft cloth, chamois or squeegee.



STEP 4

Cleaning the profiles

Clean the aluminium profiles with lukewarm water and a cleaning product with a pH value lower than 7.5. Avoid scouring pads and high pressure equipment.



CLEANING GLASS WALLS

STEP 1

Cleaning the bottom rail

Use a vacuum cleaner to remove any dirt from the bottom rail. This will ensure the sliding panels silently run along the rail.



STEP 2

Cleaning the profiles

Clean the aluminium profiles with lukewarm water and a cleaning product with a pH value lower than 7.5. Avoid scouring pads and high pressure equipment.



STEP 3

Remove dirt

Remove any loose dirt and rinse the glass panels with water.



STEP 4

Cleaning the glass plates

Clean the glass plates with lukewarm soapy water and wipe with a soft cloth, chamois or squeegee.



CLEANING WINDSCREENS

STEP 1

Cleaning the profiles

Clean the aluminium profiles with lukewarm water and a cleaning product with a pH value lower than 7.5. Avoid scouring pads and high pressure equipment.



STEP 2

Remove dirt

Remove loose dirt and rinse the glass plates with water.



STEP 3

Cleaning the glass plates

Clean the glass plates with lukewarm water and soapy water and wipe them off with a soft cloth, chamois leather or extractor.



STEP 4

Cleaning the motor and timing-belt pulley

CE MARKING

From July 1, 2014, all components of load-bearing structures made of aluminum or steel must be CE marked in accordance with NEN-EN 1090. With this CE mark, manufacturers warranty that their products meet the strict safety requirements of the legislation.

Do you have a Verano® patio roof? Then this is of course provided with CE marking. Security in and around the home is an important spearhead of Verano®. You can find more information about the NEN-EN 1090 standard on our website www.verano.nl/en/usps/safety-first/.
