SPRING CLEAN!

It goes without saying you are going to want to enjoy your Verano® product(s) for as long as possible. Cleaning the product will certainly contribute to a long life. That's why we will provide you with a step-by-step plan to help you with the cleaning.

WHAT WILL YOU NEED?



DRY LUBRICANT

ALSO CHECK:

Verano® products require little maintenance and have an incredibly long life. However, in the unlikely event of a product malfunction, contact your Verano® partner immediately. Make sure you check the following before you start cleaning your products:

- Fabric
- Aluminium profiles
- Distortion of the product
- Deviating sound when opening/closing

⚡ Tips ⚡

Take a quick look outside before you start cleaning. Is the sun shining brightly? Then postpone your cleaning activities for a little while. Firstly, because the weather is far too nice to be cleaning. And secondly, soapy water which dries too quickly can leave marks on the fabric.

CLEANING THE FABRIC

STEP 1

Remove dirt

Remove loose dirt with a brush or vacuum cleaner.



STEP 2

Removing stains

Stains can be removed with lukewarm water and a specially available cleaning agent. Don't use aggressive cleaning agents, as this could potentially affect the finish layer!



STEP 3

Rinse clean

Rinse the fabric clean with lukewarm water.



CLEANING THE ALUMINIUM

STEP 1

Remove any dirt

Remove any dust, branches and leaves with a brush.



STEP 2

Cleaning the profiles

The profiles can be cleaned with lukewarm water and a cleaning product with a pH value lower than 7.5. Avoid using scouring pads and high pressure equipment!



STEP 3

Lubricated parts

You can apply a dry lubricant, such as silicon spray, to the plastic guidance blocks, rubbers and the aluminium guidance profiles. Carefully remove any remnants of the dry lubricant.



SAFE USE

We think it's important for the safety of your living environment to remain guaranteed! We would therefore like to ask you to consider the following safety measures before you start using your product:



The tubular motor is thermally protected, in the event of overheating, the protection is activated and you are temporarily unable to use the product. As soon as the engine has cooled, the thermal protection switches off automatically.



Don't use the ritzscreen® in strong winds (>8 bft), rain, hail or snow.



Only operate the ritzscreen® when there are no people and/or obstacles in the operating area.



Always use the services of a professional installer for any repairs and/or activities.



Make sure the ritzscreen® is disconnected from the power supply when carrying out repairs and activities.
